### Programme

The programmes are research-oriented with each student being directly supervised by a faculty member.

#### MPhil Stream

- Complete all the graduate courses required by individual Departments
- When deemed necessary by advisor/supervisor, student (including non-Chinese speaking student) may be required to take a required language.
- Each MPhil student is required to give an oral presentation on his/her research progress.
- Each MPhil student is required to submit a thesis and pass the oral defence of the thesis for graduation

#### PhD Stream

##### *Pre-candidacy*

- Complete all the graduate courses required by individual Departments
- When deemed necessary by advisor/supervisor, student (including non-Chinese speaking student) may be required to take a required language.
- Each PhD student is required to pass a written candidacy examination within the maximum period of his/her-candidacy stage for the advancement to his/her post-candidacy stage.
- Submit thesis proposal and defence

##### *Post-candidacy*

- Each PhD student is required to submit a thesis and pass the oral defence of the thesis for graduation.

### Entry Requirements

Applicants must meet the general requirements of the Graduate School<sup>1</sup>. Applicants should be committed to management education. Special consideration will be given to the applicant's teaching experience and/or research publications. Interview may be required for applicants.

### Additional Application Information

Applicants are also required to submit the following documents:

1. A preliminary research proposal;
2. A statement of purpose;
3. A copy of previous written work such as a thesis, research project report, or any published articles;
4. Submission of official GMAT or GRE scores (within the past five years).

It is important to note that in principle, only applications for the full-time mode will be considered for admission. Applications for the part-time mode will not be accepted unless the applicants have an academic appointment at the time of application.

## GMAT / GRE

When registering the GMAT, applicants must use the code R9H-OW-04 in order to have the scores sent to the PhD/MPhil programmes of the Faculty of Business Administration.
