



Entrance Examination

After being assessed by the Graduate Divisions concerned, applicants may be required to take an entrance examination, which may include a subject test and/or an interview. Applicants will be notified by the Divisions/Programmes concerned directly.

Some Graduate Divisions may also require the applicants to obtain satisfactory results from the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT), the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the Graduate Record Examinations (GRE), etc. For detailed information on other entry requirements, please refer to the programme information.

Application result will be posted on the homepage of the Graduate School (www.cuhk.edu.hk/gss) from February to August 2010. Successful applicants will receive the offer letter by August 2010. Applicants may consider their applications unsuccessful if they do not hear from us thereafter.

Non-Local Student

The Graduate School welcomes non-local students. All non-local students must obtain a student visa or entry permit issued by the Director of Immigration for entering Hong Kong for the purpose of education.
