Programme

The programmes are research-oriented with each student being directly supervised by a faculty member.

MPhil Stream

- Complete all the graduate courses required by individual Departments
- When deemed necessary by advisor/supervisor, student may be required to take other courses
- Each MPhil student is required to give an oral presentation on his/her research progress
- Each MPhil student is required to submit a thesis and pass the oral defence of the thesis for graduation

PhD Stream

Pre-candidacy

- Complete all the graduate courses required by individual Departments
- When deemed necessary by advisor/supervisor, student may be required to take other courses
- Each PhD student is required to pass a written candidacy examination within the maximum period of his/her candidacy stage for the advancement to his/her post-candidacy stage
- Submit thesis proposal and defence

Post-candidacy

- Each PhD student is required to submit a thesis and pass the oral defence of the thesis for graduation.

Admission Requirements

Applicants must meet the general qualifications required for admission to the Graduate School¹. Applicants should be committed to management education. Special consideration will be given to the applicant's teaching experience and/or research publications. Interview may be required for applicants.

Additional Application Information

Applicants are also required to submit the following documents:

1. A preliminary research proposal;
2. A statement of purpose;
3. A copy of previous written work such as a thesis, research project report, or any published articles;
4. Submission of official GMAT or GRE scores (within the past five years).

It is important to note that in principle, only applications for the full-time mode will be considered for admission. Applications for the part-time mode will not be accepted unless the applicants have an academic appointment at the time of application.

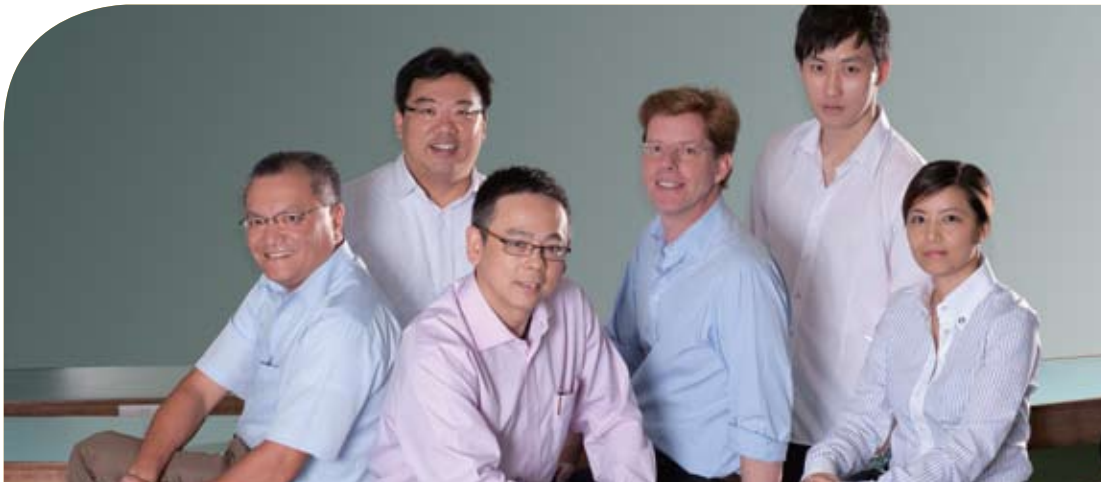
